WAREHAM – The A.D. Makepeace Company today announced that application packages for grants from the Makepeace Neighborhood Fund are now available. Applications are due March 5, 2012.

The Makepeace Neighborhood Fund was established in 2005 as a way for the A.D. Makepeace Company to provide significant support to community groups providing services the company finds important. In the past six years, the company has awarded more than \$1 million in grants for local projects and programs.

Grants are available on a competitive basis to non-profit organizations and governmental agencies which provide services to residents of Wareham, Plymouth, Carver, and Rochester. Grants typically range from \$5,000 to \$10,000 and must be in one of the following disciplines: agriculture, education, health care, community housing, historic preservation, or environmental protection.

Grants are not available to individuals.
